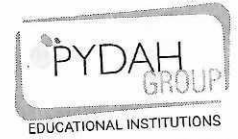

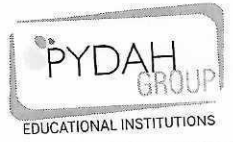

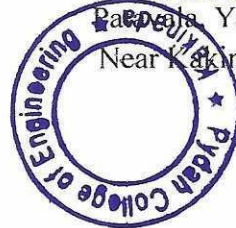

**WHEREAS:**

  - 1.1.4 Is disclosed pursuant to a judicial order, requirement of a government agency, or by operation of law
- 1.2 The Receiving Party agrees that it will not disclose the Confidential Information to any third party and will not use the confidential information other than for the performance of its obligation under this Agreement. The Receiving Party agrees that the Confidential Information shall at all times remain the sole property of the Disclosing Party and that the Receiving Party shall take all reasonable precautions to prevent any unauthorized disclosure of the Confidential Information by any of its officers, employee or any person that has access to the Confidential Information.
